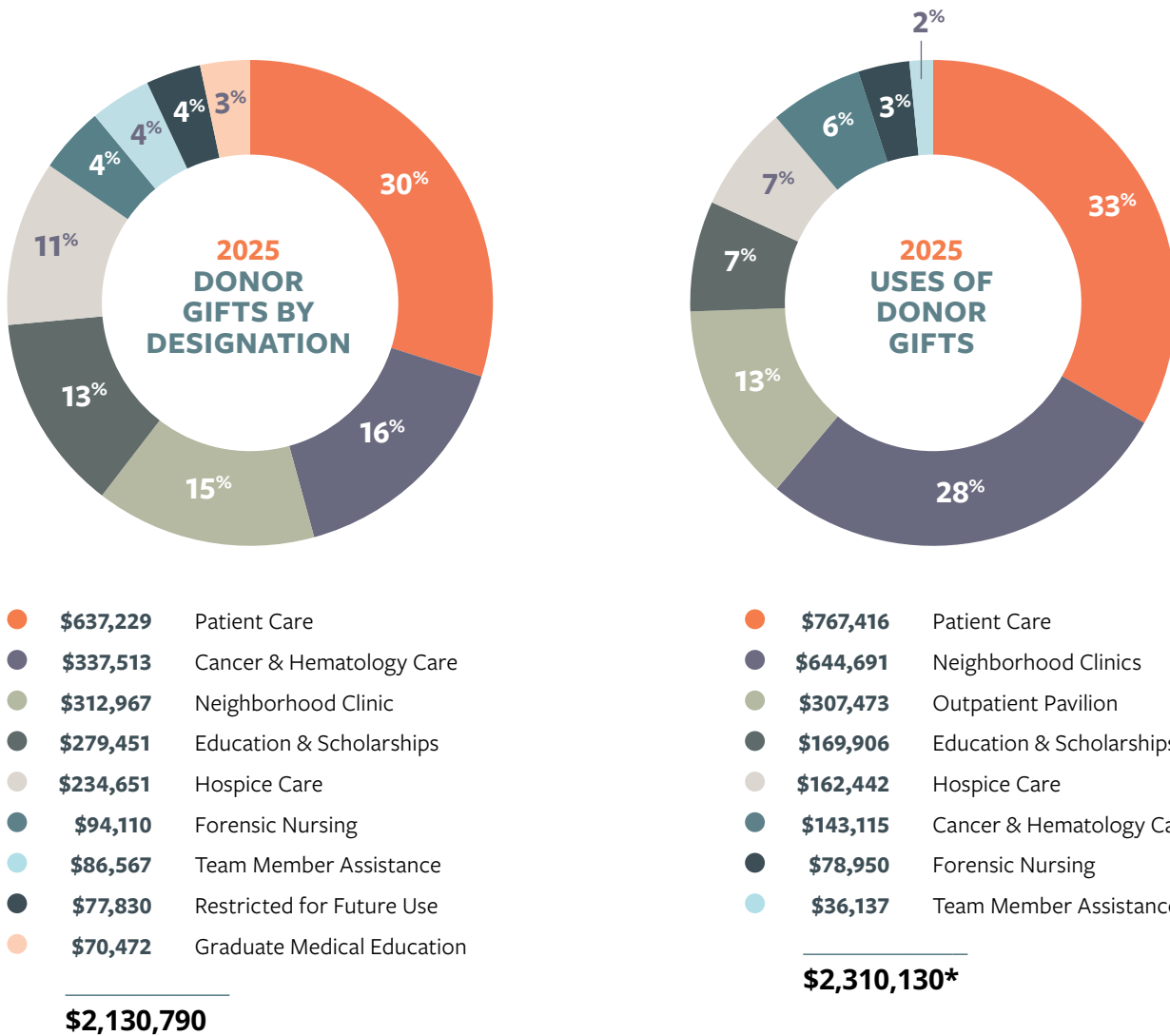

Generosity Builds

The story of the Shenandoah House renovation began with Kimberly Wright, a mother who wanted to say thank you.

Shenandoah House is a hospice house where people nearing the end of life receive around the clock care in a comfortable, home-like setting. It is where Kimberly's son, Kody, spent his final days, surrounded by compassionate nurses and volunteers who cared for him and for her family. After losing him, she carried both grief and deep gratitude for the place that had supported them.

As an employee of MidSouth Building Supply, a subcontractor for Atlantic Builders, Kimberly knew about Atlantic's annual GiveBack Home program. She nominated Shenandoah House, hoping it might receive a mid-sized grant.

It did.

When Atlantic Builders and MidSouth visited for the check presentation, they took a closer look around and saw an opportunity to do more.

"Atlantic Builders was proud to support Shenandoah House. After spending time there, we felt compelled to do more. The care happening in that space matters deeply to this community, and we wanted to help create an environment that reflects that same level of care," recalls Brian Roinestad, Atlantic's VP of Purchasing and Business Development.

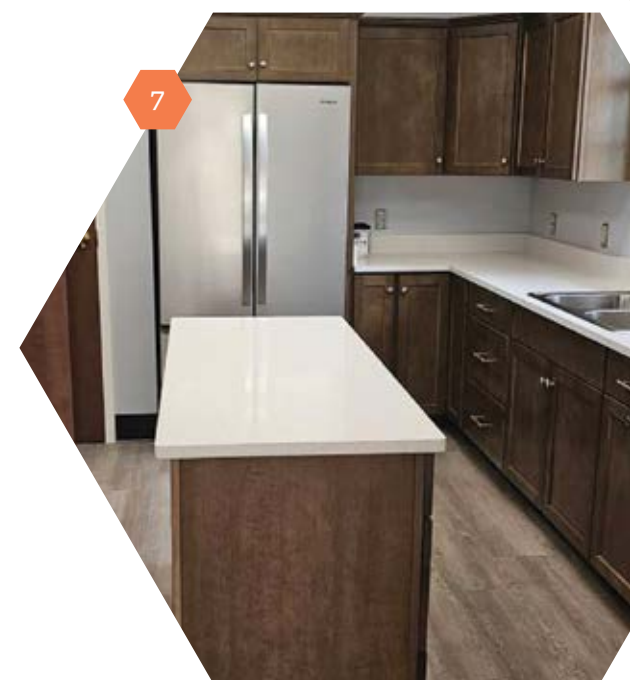
They invited key trade partners to join the project. MidSouth Building Supply, Terra Stone, and others contributed materials, and what began as a small improvement project quickly grew.

As the renovation expanded, Augusta Health Foundation helped bring additional donors into the effort. A gift from the estate of Millie Broughman, who had raised funds to build Shenandoah House in 2008, became a full-circle moment—weaving her legacy into the current renovation project.

Then two more families stepped in. One funded a private consultation room where families can meet with care teams. Another created the Carolyn Houff Family Room, offering loved ones a comfortable place to rest and stay close. With each new gift, the Foundation brought another piece into alignment, until what had started as a kitchen renovation grew into something much greater.

With support from many partners and donors, Augusta Health's in-house construction team transformed the vision into welcoming, functional spaces filled with light, comfort, and even locally donated artwork.

What Kimberly Wright set in motion with a single gesture grew far beyond what anyone had planned. A community rallied



around a place they cherish, and the results are beautiful.

Today, families who walk through the doors of Shenandoah House see welcoming spaces designed for connection and rest. They may not know the mother who started the transformation, or the suppliers who stayed committed long after the grant was spent, or the donors who gave in memory of people they loved; but they feel it.

Celebrating Champions of Local Healthcare

On December 6th, supporters gathered at Orchard Creek in Waynesboro for the annual President’s Society and Donor Recognition Reception, celebrating those whose generosity strengthens care across our region. President’s Society membership is open to all donors who give \$1,000 or more each year, to support the mission of Augusta Health. This year marked the first presentation of two new awards honoring exceptional leadership, generosity, and service.

Dr. Charles “Mick” Andersen received the inaugural Community Health Leader Award for decades of professional and volunteer service and

generous giving. Since beginning his practice in 1989, he has served in many board and committee roles, including multiple terms as chair of Augusta Medical Group. He and his wife, Anne, have contributed to the Foundation since 2006.

Rev. John C. Peterson III received the inaugural Tradition of Caring Award for his years of volunteer leadership and consistent giving. After moving to the area in 1995, he began serving on the Augusta Health Board in leadership roles, including Board Chair. Rev. Peterson and his wife, Karen, have contributed to the Foundation since 2006.

The Gift of a Lift

Most mornings, **Richard O'Shea** looks forward to spending his day behind the wheel.

He looks over his assignments — some days are busier than others — and every name on the list is someone who needs to get somewhere important. They are on their way to a doctor's visit, a follow-up, or a round of cancer treatment. For many, this ride determines whether they receive care at all.

Richard is the driver for Augusta Health's HealthRides service. The program provides transportation to patients who do not have

reliable access to a vehicle and cannot afford to pay for a ride. In a rural region with limited public transportation and few ride-share options, simply getting to an appointment can be a real barrier to receiving care. Generous gifts from community donors to Augusta Health Foundation make this vital program possible.

"We're helping people on their healing journey by making sure they can reliably get to their treatments," says Travis Simcox, Richard's supervisor and Augusta Health's coordinator for transportation and Emergency Management Service.

Before joining Augusta Health, Richard worked as a highway safety patroller, assisting stranded motorists with flat tires and roadside emergencies. He has always been someone who shows up when people need help. This role seemed like a perfect fit.

"My favorite part of the job is meeting the people," he says, "I like to ask them how

they're doing and hear about their life. It's really interesting and rewarding."

HealthRides began as an expansion of Augusta Health's transportation services. Demand grew faster than anyone anticipated, and philanthropic support has made it possible to keep pace. A grant from the Cabell Foundation combined with gifts from Carter Myers Automotive and community donations paid for the vehicle. Ongoing donations to Augusta Health Foundation will ensure that everyone who needs a ride can get one regardless of their ability to pay.

For Richard, the impact is simple: he gets people where they need to go. He shows up when they are out of other options.

Each mile the HealthRides car travels is a reminder that generosity and community care don't have to be complicated. Sometimes it's simply a ride to an appointment that might otherwise be missed... and a driver who is glad to be there.

Full Speed Ahead: A Medical Mobile Unit Update

When Augusta Health's Mobile Medical Unit launched in July 2025, the goal was clear: bring healthcare services directly into our communities. In its first seven months on the road, it has done exactly that; completing 309 patient visits by year end and reaching people who might not otherwise receive care.

Equipped to deliver a wide range of primary care services, the unit is outfitted with two exam rooms and laboratory services. Nearly 30% of those seen in 2025 were uninsured, with many others covered by Medicare and Medicaid. No one is turned away because of their inability to pay.

The Mobile Medical Unit is part of Augusta Health's broader Neighborhood Clinic services, which recorded 2,295 patient visits in 2025. People who receive care at the clinics have ongoing health concerns and benefit from consistent treatment and follow-

up. The most common conditions include hypertension, diabetes, anxiety, GERD, and COPD, along with routine immunizations.

Funded through community donations

stewarded by Augusta Health Foundation, the Mobile Medical Unit continues to expand access to care. And in less than a year, it has become a critical service that people can rely on.

Expanding Care: The Power of Community Generosity

Every year, Augusta Health Foundation works to expand resources available for community members receiving care at Augusta Health. In addition to individual and corporate giving, the Foundation secures funding from regional and national grant partners.

Securing New Resources

In 2025, the Augusta Health Foundation received **more than \$214,000 in external grant funding to complement donor supported programs** that address emerging needs, improve quality of life for patients and caregivers, and strengthen services that otherwise would not be available or affordable.

Access to Care & Community Health

Cabell Foundation a matching grant to eliminate barriers to care by investing in the Mobile Medical Unit (MMU) and purchasing health transportation vehicles that deploy health professionals to care for homebound patients and provide transportation for Augusta Health patients.

Enhancing Clinical Impact

Thanks to the generosity of our community and funding from external grant partners, **Augusta Health Foundation invested more than \$527,000 in 2025** toward meaningful initiatives that improve care, comfort, and access.

Patient Comfort & Experience

\$3,000 to provide hospice patients with Robotic Companions and Fidget Pets.

\$12,500 to re-establish the Read to Me Program and provide newborns with totes that include books and community resources.

\$20,000 to fund family and newborn photography sessions in the Mom and Baby Unit.



\$20,000 to develop a volunteer hospitality cart program for volunteers to provide comfort items to patients.

\$51,131 to purchase 12 recliners for the Skilled Nursing Unit to improve patient comfort.



Access to Care

Up to \$62,000 to fund a driver and launch a pilot ambulatory transportation program to serve patients in Augusta County and surrounding communities. (See page 7.)

Workforce Development & Training

\$1,100 for nursing team members to learn best practice techniques in safe mobility.

\$1,212 for nursing team members to learn wound care techniques using a training device called “Surgical Sally.”

\$2,500 for an oncology nurse to receive continuing education in evidence-based care at the ONS Congress Conference.

\$6,025 to purchase “Friday Night in the ER,” an interactive simulation tool to improve patient flow and quality of care.



\$11,960 for nurse leaders to receive Crucial Conversations training resources.



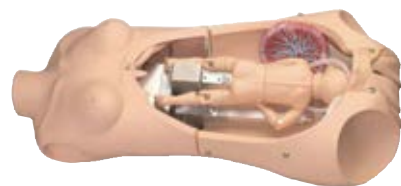

\$229,915 to fund 31 Hercules Repositioning Beds throughout the hospital to improve patient comfort and reduce team member injuries.

\$23,739 for pain medication administration technology to benefit hospice patients.

\$11,267 to purchase a birthing simulator to enhance obstetrical team training in labor and delivery skills.

\$10,000 to provide durable medical equipment for Heart Failure Clinic patients identified as needing assistance.



\$12,370 for infrared goggles to improve diagnosis of patients who need treatment for dizziness and vertigo.

Community & Home-Care Support

\$500 to purchase dog crates and leashes to keep team members safe during home health visits to patients.

\$2,000 for community members with neurological challenges to receive support in a group setting.

Spotlight: Compassion for Survivors

When someone experiences violence, access to immediate, compassionate medical care can make a lasting difference. Augusta Health’s Forensic Nursing Services ensure that those who have experienced sexual assault, abuse, strangulation, human trafficking, and other forms of interpersonal harm receive compassionate, trauma-informed medical care in a private and supportive setting.

Augusta Health is one of only 20 hospitals in Virginia to offer this level of hospital-based forensic nursing care. For people in the Shenandoah Valley, that means access to specially trained nurses close to home when it is needed most.

Grants from the **Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services**, along with **community donations** stewarded through the Foundation, make this program possible. Together, these resources support the training, staffing, and equipment required to sustain this critical service for our neighbors.

Nursing Excellence at Augusta Health

Nursing Excellence Awards, are funded by a bequest made in 1999 to honor the memory of Dr. W.C. Smith, a long-time Waynesboro pediatrician. Annual awards from the W.C. Smith Fund celebrate Augusta Health’s nurses and nursing support team members who were nominated by their peers for their dedication, innovation, leadership, and daily impact. Each award recipient receives \$1,000 to pursue a professional development opportunity of their choice, investing directly in continuous learning and excellence. 2025 honorees include: Kelsey Clarke, Nurse of the Year; Lisa Bradley, Nurse Leader of the Year; and Michael Bradley, Nurse Support Staff Member of the Year. Their work represents the dedication and compassion that define nursing at Augusta Health.

Our Creative Giving Community

When people get creative about generosity, good things happen. Throughout the year, local organizations and businesses found their own ways to bring people together and raise funds to support patients receiving care at Augusta Health.

Old Dominion Realty hosted a September car show to benefit Hospice of the Shenandoah, bringing the community together in support of compassionate end-of-life care.

The Waynesboro Woman's Club selected the SANE Fund as the focus of their International Day of Service project, helping support forensic nursing services for patients affected by violence.

Hospice of the Shenandoah held an inaugural Fallen Comrade Ceremony in November, honoring veterans while raising support for hospice patients who have served.

Rockingham Coop – Ace Hardware in Stuarts Draft invited customers to round up their purchases during October, directing funds to the Cancer Bridge Fund to assist patients in treatment.

The Tuesday Club of Augusta County named the Neighborhood Clinic Mobile Medical Unit as a beneficiary of their annual giving, helping expand access to care throughout the region.

Team Members Find Their Cause

Team members give back to support each other and the work they do to care for our communities through the “Find Your Cause. Fund Your Cause.” campaign. Once again, a record number of team members, nearly 800, raised over \$300,000 to support 38 causes including patient care, heart and vascular, neighborhood clinics, and cancer services. Team members continue to support each other through the Team Member Emergency Fund which provides one-time assistance to colleagues who experience personal emergencies that result in financial hardship.

Giving Back, While Planning Ahead

When Dave Maccarelli returned to Waynesboro after a 10-year tour of the Carolinas, he knew he wanted to support Augusta Health again. Having seen how healthcare privatization can affect patient care and the professionals who provide it, he was grateful his hometown health system remained community owned.

Looking for ways to contribute, Dave first offered his time. As a retired corporate executive, he offered to serve (again) on the Finance Committee of the Augusta Health Board of Directors. Before long, he began thinking about how he could support Augusta Health financially as well.

Through an **IRA Charitable Rollover**, Dave discovered he could satisfy a portion of his **Required Minimum Distribution** from his IRA by funding a **Charitable Gift Annuity**. The arrangement allowed him to avoid increasing his taxable income in the year of the donation, while receiving dependable annual payouts for life.

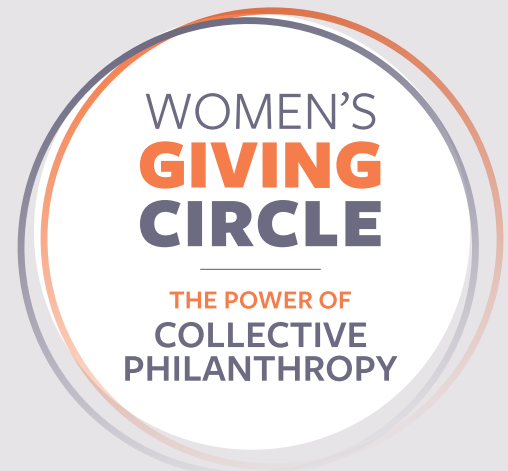
